Clive Community Foundation Names Board Officers at Spring Meeting

Jane Fogg to serve as 2020-2021 board president

CLIVE, IOWA – June 11, 2020 – At its May meeting of the board of directors, the Clive Community Foundation (CCF) named Jane Fogg as its new board president, replacing Scott Cirksena, Clive mayor. Cirksena is the initial founder of the foundation and has served as president since 2018. He will continue his leadership on the board as immediate past president.

Fogg has served on the foundation board since 2018, and most recently as vice president. Her professional experience has centered on public education and community change. She held the position of community impact officer for the United Way of Central Iowa, leading efforts to improve economic self-sufficiency of low income families. She served three terms on the West Des Moines school board. Fogg and her husband, Eric, are long-time Clive residents.

John Rigler III, board vice president, is president and chief operating officer of Peoples Bank in Clive. Rigler joined the foundation board in 2019 and remains involved in several community and economic development initiatives. Rigler and his family live in Urbandale.

The Clive Community Foundation has led and funded several Clive-area projects since its inception in 2013. These community initiatives range from investment in public art – like the 18-foot Marasco sculpture at NW 128th Street and Woodlands Parkway, or the Clive Historical Foundation mural – to meeting human service needs through support of Clive Community Services and the Clive Lions Club. The foundation also supports programs for children and youth including the Crestview Elementary Girl Scouts and participating in sports and cultural events.
